Mayor Darrell Mehlhaf called the meeting to order at 6:10 p.m. Answering roll call: George Cokens, Ronald Diede, Jerry Fischer, Jerome Kotalik (entered at 6:12 p.m.) and Scott Simonsen; Galen Guthmiller absent. School Board Representative Theresa Mettler and Finance Officer Peggy Thranum were also present.

Diede **moved** to approve the agenda. Cokens seconded; all ayes.

Equalization: Assessment books and lists of improvements were reviewed by those present. There were no appeals filed. Mettler left the meeting at 6:25 p.m.
