

Parent and Player Guidelines for Behavior

THESE GUIDELINES ARE FOR BOTH PARENTS AND PLAYERS

- **No yelling or swearing**
- **No fighting:** Respect your teammates and coaches
- **Obey coaches:**
 1. No talking back
 2. All players and parents need to show respect towards coaches and the Menno Athletic Board
 3. Parents advice will be considered, but the coaches have the final say
 - 4. Parents MUST stay out of the dugouts, NO STANDING BEHIND THE DUGOUTS and must stay off the fields during and after games unless there is an emergency involving your child**
 - 5. No YELLING at players or coaches**

1. **1st violation of conduct:** The coach will contact the parents regarding their child or the Menno Athletic Board regarding a parent (parents this will be your only warning).
2. **2nd violation of conduct:** The coach will notify the Menno Athletic Board and they will contact the parent regarding their child.
3. **3rd violation of conduct:** STRIKE 3, you are out!!!

If there are any issues or concerns with the summer sports programs please follow this Chain of Command:

1. **Coach or Coaches:** PLEASE WAIT TO TALK WITH THE COACHES UNTIL THE DAY AFTER A GAME. **PLEASE BE CIVIL!!**

2. Menno Athletic Board

If a situation becomes out of control between parents and coaches, the coaches will notify Menno Athletic Board. The Menno Athletic Board will be in contact with the parents.

The Menno Athletic Board reserves the right to terminate participation of players or parents, depending upon the seriousness of the violation, as they see fit.
